The Sports Exhibition Programme has been fixed by the Organizing Committee. It is as follows:

Tennis

A series of matches will take place at the Country Club the Guadalajara Club and Deportivo Atlas in the town of Guadalajara (State of Jalisco) from October 13 to 20

Some Exhibition Matches, in which the winners of the Guadalajara Tournament will take part, will be held in the "Centro Deportivo Chapultepec", Mexico, on October 24,25 & 26.

Fronton Games

The competitions of the various Fronton Games (Frontenis, Pelote, paleta, with leather and rubber balls) will take place at Mexico from October 14 to 20

* The Exhibition will be held at Acapulco at Mexico from October 21 to 25.

The Organizing Committee of the XIth Winter Games have published their programme of Olympic constructions, and subsequent utilization of the different sites for tests.

The track for luge races at Fujino can be used next winter, at the same time, the covered rink for ice-hockey at Mikaho, the slalom courses at Mont Teine and the downhill tracks at Mont Eniwa can be partially used.

All the proposed competition sites are situated within a radius of 20 kms from the Olympic Village, with the exception

of the speed-skating training rink at Tomakoma. The Olympic Village is 7 kms from the centre of the town of Sapporo.

M_u_n_i_c_h

Mr. Willi DAUME, Members of the International Olympic Committee, and President of the Organizing Committee for the Munich Games has presented the the Press the emblem retained by the city of Munich for the Games in 1972. This is the work of the designer Coordt von MANSTEIN of Cologne. The poster is oblong in shape and includes the five Olympic rings above with a blue and white spiral, releived in green and silver below.
