RAPPORT DE L'OPERATION ORTO (Report of ORTO's Operations) - Official report of the Canadian Broadcasting Corporation, host broadcaster for the Games of the XXIst Olympiad at Montreal in 1976. Published by ORTO's Office of External Relations. 1977, bilingual French and English.

This very complete and detailed report will first and foremost enable professionals and future organisers of Olympic Games to understand the reality of the televised broadcasting of the Olympic Games better, and the outsider to gain insight into the incredible complexity of this operation.

INTERVAL TRAINING, by Edward L. Fox and Donald K. Mathews. Published by Editions Vigot, 23, rue de l'Ecole-de-Médecine, 75006 Paris (FRA). 1977, 276 pages, in French. Price: 55 French francs.

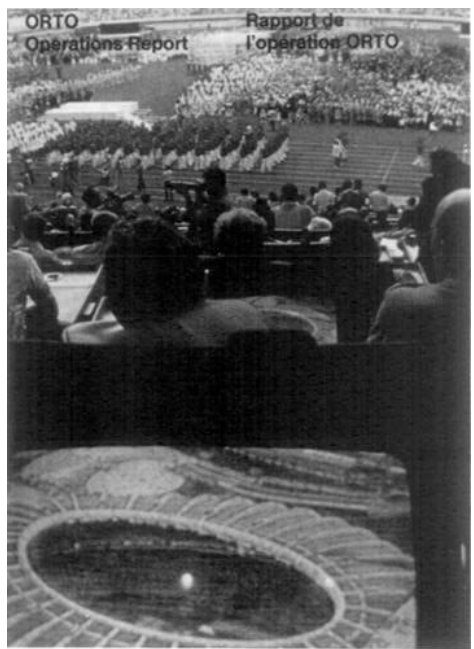
This book is the French translation of the work published by W.B. Saunders Company (Philadelphia, USA) in 1974.

The sub-title of "Preparation for sport and improvement of general physical condition" gives a better idea of the scope of this work which is intended by the authors to enable each trainer, athlete or simply anybody who wants to be "on form" to establish an individual programme of interval training and to ascertain its benefits on health and sports performances.

SPORT ET CREATIVITE (Sport and Creativity), by Florence and Alain Guillon. Published by Editions Universitaires, 10, rue Mayet, 75006 Paris (FRA). 1976, 192 pages, in French. Price: 45 French francs.

The authors have sought to clarify a new dimension attributed to sport—its original cultural status; a psychological approach, through numerous interviews with athletes, an attempt at a theoretical model, linked to an original definition of sport.



LES DOCUMENTS FRANCE-SOIR - EUROPE No 1 - JEUX OLYMPIQUES MONTREAL 1976 et LA COURSE TRANSATLANTIQUE EN SOLITAIRE (Documentation of France-Soir and Europe No. 1 - 1976 Montreal Olympic Games and Single-handed Transatlantic Race). Published by France-Soir - CILP, 2, avenue de Garlande, 92221 Bagneux (FRA). 1976, in French. Price: 9.50 French francs each.

Prepared before the 1976 Games and the Single-handed Transatlantic Yacht Race, these two brochures briefly recall the history of each event or edition. The presentation is pleasing and clear, and the illustrations avoid often unnecessary description.

LE CORPS (The Body), by Michel Bernard. Published by Editions Jean-Pierre Delarge, 10, rue Mayel, 75006 Paris (FRA). 1976, 146 pages, in French. Price: 25 French francs.

Doctor of philosophy, Michel Bernard looks at the modern rediscovery of the body, which seems to conduce to its revalorisation. He intends to show that this liberation is deceptive since "the reality of our bodies is formed by our unconscious fantasies, reflections of the myths invented by our society".

OLYMPIA DER REITER (The Riders' Olympics), official publication of the German Equestrian Federation presided by Count Dieter van Landsberg-Velen. Published by Olympische Sport Bibliothek, Munich (GER). 1977, 240 pages, in German.

This very beautiful, magnificently illustrated book, which is devoted entirely to the various equestrian competitions at the Games of the XX1st Olympiad, will enthral all riding enthusiasts and horsemen around the world.

SPORT SOCIOLOGY BULLETIN, edited by Benjamin Lowe. Published by the College of Human Learning and Development, Governors State University, Park Forest South, Illinois 60466 (USA).

This 1977 spring issue (No. 1, volume 6) contains interesting articles on animals in sport, the effects of culture on women's experience in sport, the role of sport in the development of ethnicity, child development through low organisational games, as well as a very useful bibliography.

TRAUMATOLOGIE DU SPORT EN PRACTIQUE MEDICALE COURANTE (Sports Traumatology in Modern Medical Practice), by Jean Genety and Elisabeth Brunet-Guedj. Published by Editions Vigot, 23, rue de l'Ecole-de-Médecine, 75006 Paris (FRA). 1976, 328 pages, in French.

Sport involves the idea of excess and risk, that is of accident. In the eyes of the public, the sports doctor only "treats cartilages". In actual fact, sports traumatology should be considered from various different angles; although some injuries are absolutely the same as those in everyday life, other slight injuries which would hardly be noticed are disastrous for an athlete, and indeed there is a third type of injury which is related to sport and linked to the techniques employed. The incomparable experience of Dr. Genety, whose enthusiasm has been fired by sports medicine for more than 20 years, is made available to all athletes, coaches and doctors who will undoubtedly benefit enormously.

SOCIOLOGIE POLITIQUE DU SPORT (Political Sociology of Sport), by Jean-Marie Brohm. Published by Editions Jean-Pierre Delarge, 10, rue Mayet, 75006 Paris (FRA). 1977, 352 pages, in French. Price: 69.95 French francs.

This work analyses the birth and structure of the sports establishment in relation to the development of the capitalist world from a political point of view.

ABC DU TIR A L'ARC - POURQUOI PAS MOI? (ABC of Archery - Why Not Me?), by Raymond Matzinger and Bernard Boulets. Distributed by Librairie Payot, rue de Bourg 1, 1000 Lausanne (SUI). 1976, 75 pages, in French.

An Olympic sport, archery is within everyone's reach. This guide for the beginner, written in particular by the new Secretary General of the Fédération Internationale de Tir à l'Arc (FITA), is especially intended "to initiate those who have heard about archery occasionally, who one day cut a branch of hazel, or who enjoyed playing cowboys and Indians".

A pleasant and instructive book, very sensibly illustrated, this small publication should help them discover a fulfilling sport.
